



Courses: Weekend classes provide 8 hours of workshop time and Weeklong classes provide 20 hours of workshop time. Instructors are generally available and the Livery Hall is available for jamming during evening hours. On weekends, a Saturday evening concert will be presented by the instructor at nearby Meadowcroft Rockshelter and Museum of Rural Life.



Lodging: Weatherbury Farm offers on-site lodging in a cluster of historic buildings. Three two story suites and two rooms are available. All suites and rooms have ensuite bathrooms with clawfoot tub and shower. Lodging reservations are taken on a first come/first served basis. Weekly Lodging Rates:

- \$150 per person -- sleeper sofa in room (2 person room)
- \$175 per person -- bed in room (2 person room)
- \$200 per person -- sleeper sofa in two-story suite (3 person suite)
- \$225 per person -- bed in two-story suite (3 person suite)

Check-in is 4:00 PM on Sunday; check-out is 11:00 AM on Friday.

Weekend Lodging Rates:

- \$60 per person -- sleeper sofa in room (2 person room)
- \$70 per person -- bed in room (2 person room)
- \$80 per person -- sleeper sofa in two-story suite (3 person suite)
- \$90 per person -- bed in two-story suite (3 person suite)

Check-in is 4:00 PM on Friday; check-out is 11:00 AM on Sunday

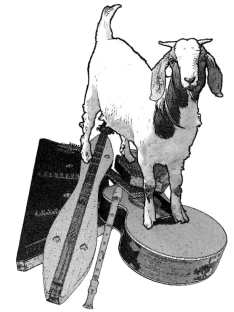


Dining: The hall in the Livery provides the setting for breakfast and lunch. Both vegetarian and non-vegetarian fare are offered.
